This workshop looks at multicultural games played by children around the world. This links particularly well with the recent focus on the creative approach to the delivery of the curriculum. Pupils develop an awareness and appreciation for different cultures while enjoying physical activity from playing the various games. This workshop can last between 30 - 50 minutes. Pupils will enjoy a range of games from China, Nigeria, the United States, and many other countries. There is also a geography aspect to this workshop, in which children will locate and identify different countries on a world map.

- * For pupils to develop an awareness and appreciation for different cultures.
- * To facilitate a discussion about favourite games.

The objective of the session is:

- * To help pupils see life through the eyes of a child in the land the game originated.
- * For pupils to recognise the role of games in getting to know and understand others of like and different backgrounds and recognise the importance of one's personal heritage.
